Energy crisis

We would like to bring to your attention especially to the efficiency checklist (attached). We recommend site managers, maintenance staff, take the following steps where possible:-

- Energy monitoring Did you know that site managers or account holders can monitor their utilities directly with WME? You can login in <u>here</u>.
- Being proactive with monitoring will help reduce energy consumption and spend.
- Switch off heating where buildings or "zones" aren't occupied.
- Heating controls and thermostats should match the usage/occupancy times.
- Check hot water systems and immersion tanks/timers are set correctly.
- Familiarise yourselves with the heating controls to avoid expensive callouts.
- Make sure thermostats are set correctly (18°C is adequate in the workplace).
- Avoid external windows and doors being open where possible whilst the heating on.
- Shut down ICT systems and lighting after use and outside of operating hours.
- Ensure that heating, lighting, and ICT systems are shutdown wherever possible during holidays and weekends.

Workshops 2022
