The Royal British Legion 'Lamp Post Poppies' continue to be a success in local communities and on social media. I have already had a few enquires for orders of the event poppies for VE/VJ Day as people will be organising street parties and celebrations.

In order to be organised, and to avoid a last minute panic trying to source the poppies, we thought it best to reach out to all the Parish Councils in Shropshire and Telford & Wrekin to see who would like to take part in this way.

I'll need to know how many poppies you would like to order, and based upon a donation of £3 per poppy I will send you an donation invoice with BACS or cheque donation options. I will require orders by the <u>1st May</u>, so that I can get the order placed and delivered to you in time. I will also need an address on where to send the poppies to.

Payments will be needed before the 1st August. I will be the contact for this, but once the money is banked it will be assigned to your district tally and I will be in communication with your local volunteers so they know what was raised in the area. You would then retain the poppies for next year.

It is recommended that you speak to your local highways team on the rules and regulations for putting the poppies on lamp posts so that they don't obstruct sightlines or place them on railings etc.
