Notes from The Annual Parish Meeting of Knockin held in the Assembly Rooms, Knockin on Tuesday, 8th May 2018 at 7:00 PM

5 members of the public present.

1. Welcome and Opening Remarks by the Chairman of the Parish Council,
Councillor C. Keay welcomed everyone to the meeting.

2. To approve the minutes of the annual parish meeting held 9.5.17

3. Annual Report of the Parish Council 2017/2018, presented by the Chairman, Councillor C. Keay presented his report and outlined the work of the council over the past year (attached to notes).

4. Reports to the Parish Meeting from:

Oswestry Rural South Safer Neighbourhood Team – CSO Iremonger gave a report on recent crimes and disturbances in the parish. He reported that over the year the main issue had been speeding through the village and speed enforcement work would continue. There had been an increase in the number of burglaries in the area generally however the Police are confident that the culprit will be caught. It was reported that due to cuts there is only one Police Sergeant now covering the whole of the North Shropshire Area.
